

TIPS:

BüllsPort is the *ideal stopover* at the beginning or end of your round trip through southern Namibia. When travelling from South Africa, it provides a peaceful break on the way to the Namibian coast.

Route of History via B1 and C24 (90 km tar and 145 km gravel road): Rehoboth with museum about the history of the Basters, Sam Khubis memorial commemorating the skirmish between the Basters and Germans (1915).

Route of Landscapes via C26, D1265, 1261 and 1275 (285 km gravel road): Khomas Highlands with bush savannah, Great Escarpment (Spreetshoogte-Pass), Namib and Naukluft valley.

Stay a minimum of **two nights** to have enough time to leisurely conquer the Naukluft mountains – whether on foot or on horseback, in a 4x4 or on a mountain bike. Join us on a farm drive, and discover how farming works at the edge of the Namib.

Day trip to Sossusvlei (self-drive, 376 km): Via Tsauchab valley (D854) to Sesriem (133 km), in the afternoon visit Sossusvlei (to avoid the crowds; 2x 60 km), back via Naukluft Gorge (C14) enjoying the colour play of the setting sun (123 km).
